In 2023, BSRU reported 9,576 full-time equivalent (FTE) students across six faculties. Of these, the largest proportion of graduates earned less than 150,000 Baht per year, with 59.2% (5,668 students) falling into this income range. A smaller percentage (6.7%) reported earning more than 300,000 Baht per year, indicating that high-earning graduates are relatively limited. Notably, the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences had the highest student population (2,792), while Industrial Engineering and Technology had the smallest (510). Around 6.4% (612 students) reported having no income, and 7.4% (713 students) provided no data.
